BRIDGES ACROSS BORDERS NON-CREDIT, PRO-BONO SUMMER PROGRAM IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

Through a partnership with Bridges Across Borders (BAB), an international, non-profit, non-governmental organization, the Saint Louis University School of Law's clinical program offers a small number of non-credit, pro-bono summer internships in Southeast Asia. Students are stationed in Cambodia, Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia or Laos. Working with local attorneys, students participate in a variety of transitional justice and community legal education initiatives.

APPLICATION, FINANCES, AND PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

Additionally, students must review the SLU Proposal for Bridges Across Borders which is available in Students Services and on the law school website. Bridges Across Borders administers the practical arrangements of the program. The program administration fee for each 2009 intern was \$1800, and the program required attendees to raise an additional \$100 to donate to the organization. The cost for the 2010 program has not been announced. The program administration fee does not include airfare, accommodation, visas, food, or daily transit to and from work.

Saint Louis University School of Law requires students in this program to purchase the school's International Health Insurance and International Student Identification Card. The cost will be approximately \$300 for both during the summer of 2010.

As SLU Law's Clinical faculty assist students in locating fellowships that are available to defray the cost of travel, housing and other expenses, they require that students submit their application and a complete SLU Proposal for Bridges Across Borders to Beth Anderson Jennings by the deadline noted below.

DEADLINE

Students must submit their application (downloaded from the BAB website) and the SLU Proposal for Bridges Across Borders with all attachments to Beth Anderson Jennings in Student Services no later than *Friday, December 18, 2010* at 5:00 p.m.
